2006 Rule Proposals

Proposal 1

No franchise will be allowed to add / drop or trade either of its team defenses.

Proposal 2

A penalty will be assessed for any franchise that violates the salary cap or floor during the NFA Draft. The penalty will be the loss of the third-highest salaried player from the franchise's roster. The franchise must then select a player in such a manner that will comply with both the salary cap and floor.

Proposal 3

A franchise will be allowed to designate the same player as its franchise player for no more than three consecutive seasons.

Proposal 4

If a player is placed on injured reserve in the NFL, the NFA franchise must place that player on NFA injured reserve as well. All other details regarding injured reserve in the NFA still apply.

Proposal 5

Along with the established NFA salary cap and floor, a rookie salary cap should be in place. This rookie salary cap would be a component of the overall salary cap, not additional money.
